12-74 Motion to pass the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby determines that the owner's maintenance of vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris upon the following properties constitutes a nuisance:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of this Board's intent to provide for the abatement, control or removal of said vegetation, garbage, refuse or other debris constituting said nuisance be given to all owners of the land and holders of liens of record upon said land in accordance with **Section 505.87 (B) O.R.C.**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon proper notice, and failure of the property owner to abate said nuisance within seven days, the Board of Trustees provide for the abatement, control or removal of said vegetation, garbage, refuse or other debris constituting said nuisance in accordance with **Section 505.87 (B) O.R.C.**

12-75 Motion to pass the following resolution:

A Resolution declaring the five year 1.25 mil levy in excess of the ten mil limitation approved by the township electors in November 2008 for the purpose of operating and maintaining a Township 9-1-1-system no longer necessary and to terminate further collection of the tax in the 2013 collection year (pursuant to R.C. 5705.19)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Liberty Township has adopted and approved Township Resolution No. 12-71, on April 9, 2012, terminating and ceasing operations of the Liberty Township 9-1-1-Secondary PSAP Dispatch Center as soon as practicable, on or before December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said termination and cessation of operations of the Liberty Township 9-1-1 Secondary PSAP Dispatch Center as soon as practicable, on or before December 31, 2012, the five year 1.24 mil levy in excess of the ten mil limitation approved by the township electors at the November 2008 general election for the purpose of operating and maintaining a township 9-1-1 System is deemed no longer needed; and

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the township terminate the 2012 tax assessment of said levy and the collection of the levy funds in the 2013 collection year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Fiscal Officer certify a copy of this Resolution to the Trumbull County Auditor, to reflect the termination of the 2012 tax assessment and the collection of the levy funds in the 2013 collection year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees be and hereby is authorized to take any and all further action necessary to effect said termination of the 2012 tax assessment and the collection of the levy funds in the 2013 collection year upon the tax duplicate.
