13-95 Motion made by Mr. Rubin to pass ORC §505.17 Resolution Regulating Vehicle Parking:

WHEREAS, the township deems it necessary to regulate parking of the motor vehicles within the township, now therefore;

BE IT RESOVED, that the following location shall be designated as a no parking zone;

“NO PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STREET OF SUNNY DRIVE”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Order be posted by the Township Fiscal Officer in five (5) conspicuous places in the Township for thirty days, before becoming effective and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Order be published in the Review appearing once a week for three consecutive weeks; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Order be posted on one or more traffic signs at the location of the designated no parking zone.
