NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby establishes the "Liberty in Bloom" Community Improvement Project to promote the beautification of Liberty Township by the location and planting of flowers, plants, trees, shrubs and other foliage on township property and public right of ways within the township; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees solicits the support of township resident volunteer labor, financial contributions and/or donations of flowers, plants, trees in kind, to be used in conjunction with funds and /or labor provided by the township for such purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESLOVED, that the Board of Trustees establish a line item township fund to accept financial donations and appropriate funds for the Liberty in Bloom Community Beautification Project activities.
