14-72 Motion made by Mrs. Stoyak to hire Joy Wilden, 32 Beaver Ave., Niles Ohio 44446 per the guidelines of the Teamster Local #377 Clerical Contract pending pre-employment drug testing. Hire Date 5/28/14.

14-73 Motion made by Mrs. Stoyak to pass the following resolution amending the Liberty Township Police Department Guidelines and Rotation towing Policy

WHEREAS, Liberty Township has established its Police Department Guidelines and Rotation Towing Policy effective May 22, 2007, which currently allows the township to collect certain fees for towing/impound of motor vehicles towed, removed, ordered into storage or impounded within the township; and

WHEREAS, Liberty Township has determined an increase in the current fee in necessary in order for the township to continue to provide a fair and equitable monetary standard for the public in conjunction with police towing services; and

WHEREAS, Liberty Township has determined that the fee for towing/impound of motor vehicles towed, removed, ordered into storage or impounded within the township shall be increased by \$25.00 per tow, increasing the cost of a Standard Police Tow to \$110.00 and a Flatbed Police Tow to \$125.00, with the \$25.00 increase payable to Township.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Liberty Township Police Department Guidelines and Rotation Towing Policy be and hereby is amended to add the increase of \$25.00 for towing/impound of motor vehicles towed, removed, ordered into storage or impounded within the township, increasing the cost of a Standard Police Tow to \$110.00 and a Flatbed Police Tow to \$125.00, with the \$25.00 increase payable to the Township; and

BE IT THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Liberty Township Board of Trustees and/or the Liberty Township Police Chief be and hereby are authorized to prepare and execute any documentation required to effect this price increase for police tows within the township; and

BE TI THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED, that this amendment to the Liberty Township Police Department guidelines and Rotation Towing Policy be and hereby is effective as of the earliest date allowable by law.
