

The Board of Liberty Township Trustees met in Regular Session on June 28, 2018 at 7:30 a.m. at the township Administration Building with the following members present, Mr. Gregory Cizmar, and Mr. Arnold Clebone, presiding. Mrs. Jodi K. Stoyak was absent.

Presentation on costs and savings on replacing Township Light Bulbs with LED's with 1<sup>st</sup> Energy Rebate program. Yesco Electric Supplier compared cost vs. savings. Township should see savings after 10 months plus a 35%/40% drop in bills. Trustee Cizmar to work with representative.

Township Health Insurance renewal with Medical Mutual of Ohio discussed.

Bids on 2018 OPWC partially funded road projects have come in. Two bids: Shelly & Sand and American. Will take bids under advisement and wait until County recommends bidder.

YSU Road Condition Map- reviewed detailed map.

Discussion on Road Levy to be placed on November Ballot: Board will have the first public meeting on July 24, 2018 to place on November ballot.

Items to be placed for sale on Govdeal.com. Ambulance and any other miscellaneous items.

Discussed the Fifth Avenue welcome to Liberty sign which was knocked down by a car last winter. Trinkle Sign to repair the sign for \$225. The Board has authorized the repairs.

Discussed Liberty School Superintendent Joe Nohra's request to add a page to the School's Annual Report sent to every household. The cost would be approximately \$1500. Trustee Clebone was not in favor but would consider putting something personal in it.

Discussed crack seal. Tim Monroe has been in contact with the County over this issue.
