

The Board of Liberty Township Trustees met in a Regular Session on Thursday, September 6, 2018 at 7:30 a.m. at the township Administration Building with the following members present, Mr. Gregory Cizmar, and Mr. Arnold Clebone, presiding. Mrs. Jodi K. Stoyak was absent. Also present Administrator Pat Ungaro, Fire Chief Gus Birch, Interim Chief Toby Meloro and Code Enforcement Officer Jim Rodway.

Fire Dept. to discussed emergency situations when storm damage happen on County Roads. County has a policy to call Ohio Edison for downed wires. However, Chief wants a solution so as not to tie up his manpower and equipment for hours. It was suggested the Chief contact other communities in Trumbull County to 1) see if they too are experiencing the same issues with the County; 2) Look into creating a disaster service who could respond to those types of matters.

Interim Chief Toby Meloro reported the administration roof leaks were caused by the air conditioner units. Drains must be kept open. However, it was decided to contact Roth Brothers to make sure the roof is sound and to get possible quote on a new roof.

Community Reinvestment Area – new application request came from Nick Coggins regarding possible tax abatement for Rally’s was discussed with Code Officer Jim Rodway.

LED lighting – Pat to call University Electric to see if they’ve completed the labor cost to convert township owned lights.

Discussed the repairs for outside sign. Trustee Cizmar and Trustee Clebone agreed to repair the sign.
