

The Board of Liberty Township Trustees met in a Regular Session on October 25, 2018 at 7:30 a.m. at the township Administration Building with the following members present, Mr. Gregory Cizmar, and Mr. Arnold Clebone, presiding. Mrs. Jodi K. Stoyak was absent. Also in attendance were Administrator Pat Ungaro, Fire Chief Gus Birch, Interim Police Chief Toby Meloro, & Road Senior Foreman Tim Monroe.

Discussed the proposal from Powell's Landscaping to remove two dead trees at the administration building (on Police Side) for \$200. Both trustees in attendance agreed to have them removed.

Discussed hand held radios with both Chiefs and the upcoming change at the County 911 Center which may entail the need for new radios. The Fire Chief has entered into a grant request with a consortium of twps. Led by Champion as discussed at last week's meeting. If the grant is acquired 90 percent of the cost will be covered with the twp. Cost estimated at about \$10,000.

Discussed the potential change in BWC transporting across the State Line as there was some issue about whether or not Ohio BWC would cover medical cost of twp. employees involved in accident in PA. Policy of Twp has been not to transport patients across state line to hospital. With closing of northside there may be more potential to use Sharon Hospital and hence need to change policy. Trustee Clebone said he would review policy and report back to the board.

Discussed Civil Service process for hiring including timing and costs.
