

The Board of Liberty Township Trustees met in a Regular Session on November 8, 2018 at 7:30 a.m. at the township Administration Building with the following members present, Mr. Gregory Cizmar, and Mr. Arnold Clebone, presiding. Mrs. Jodi K. Stoyak was absent. Also in attendance were Administrator Pat Ungaro, Fire Chief Gus Birch, Interim Police Chief Toby Meloro, & Road Senior Foreman Tim Monroe

Hercules representative followed by Winkle Electric answered questions on bids to township to install LED lighting in and around buildings. Trustees indicated decision would be made subsequent to obtaining information on quality of bulbs being installed by each. Winkle indicated that they would consider including one year labor as part of their guarantee that only included bulbs for five years. Hercules bid was considerably higher with five year guarantee on bulb and labor for certain lamps and two years for other.

Chief Meloro discussed the potential for needing new server; he was joined by Sergeant Buhala in explaining the need. Meloro said he would get at least two bids.

As follow-up to last week's discussion it was considered appropriate and necessary to, when requested by patients for Twp ambulance to transport across state line. Policy of Twp has been not to transport patient across state line to hospital because it was thought twp employees may not be covered by worker's compensation. With confirmation by Attorney Poteet that township employees are covered Trustees authorized Fire Chief to authorize transport across state lines.
