

The Board of Liberty Township Trustees met in a Regular Session on March 21, 2019 at 7:30 a.m. at the township Administration Building with the following members present, Mr. Gregory Cizmar, and Mr. Arnold Clebone, presiding. Discussion:

Township Roof. Jeff, CT Consultants, offered the assistance of Chris DeLucca Construction Engineer who can aid the township and recommend patching or repairing an overlay of the entire roof.

Arnie discussed a possible survey by Republic Waste on asking residents if once a month for recycling is acceptable since the industry has reduced the types of recyclables which can be recycled in order to damage the roads less with the heavy garbage/recycling vehicles.

Tim spoke with Jeff, CT Consultants, on Clean Ohio Grants, as well as Tr. County Soil and Water eligibility for the stream erosion at Churchill Park. Also spoke about ordering picnic tables and new swings for the park. Still need to have someone look at the deck to see what repairs need done. Austintown Fence will look at ball field fence.
